"Be Holy, For I Am Holy"

God's word to us says, "But as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, 'Be holy, for I am holy'" (1 Peter 1:15-16). To be holy we are told to present our "bodies as a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God" (2 Corinthians 7:1), and "that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love" (Ephesians 1:4).

We must be holy in all our thoughts, actions, dress, and speech. If our thoughts are not holy then our actions, dress, and speech will not be holy. "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he" (Proverbs 23:7). We act as we think. If we want to be pure and holy then we will have "sound speech that cannot be condemned" (Titus 2:8).
