Can The Lord Ride With The Way We Live?

A man was driving and hit a telephone pole. A pedestrian came to check on him and said: "Are you alright?" The man in the car said: "I am alright because the Lord was with me." The pedestrian answered: "Well, next time you need to let the Lord ride with me b/c I think you were trying to kill Him."

The question we have to ask ourselves is: "Can the Lord ride with the way that we live? What I mean by that is: would the Lord approve of the places I go, the friends that I hang with, the things I watch on TV, the things that I talk about, etc? God realizes that we all sin, but do we walk in darkness? John wrote: "If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:6-9). If we are not careful we can get this philosophy that teaches: "I can live any way I want during the week, then come to church on Sunday and everything is fine." Paul wrote: "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God" (Romans 12:1-2). You know, this type of thing does not come over night. It takes a mind-set of reaching for your spiritual goals. Friend, do you have spiritual goals? I pray that we will all set goals in our lives in these areas where they are most important.

May we all take the steps needed to continue moving forward in our relationships with God! May god bless you on your journey to walk in the Light of the Gospel!
