Biblical New Year Resolutions

Another year passes and we are made aware of our most precious, fragile gift: time. Benjamin Franklin wrote "Dost thou love life? Then waste not time, for that is the stuff that life is made of." Our use of time determines success or failure. Surely it is fitting that we make some Biblical new year's resolutions to direct us into the future. Let us look at the word "resolutions" for this article.



Let us resolve to stay in the RACE (Hebrews 12:1). In this race, we must be able to take it and not give up.
