We live in a world of dishonesty. People lie for one reason or another. People will lie even when they have sworn to tell the truth. In some (for example, politicians) it is almost expected they will lie and sadly, accepted. It ought not to be true among Christians. It is not true about God. God cannot lie (Titus 1:2).
