(Sounds like something Jesus said)

In the greatest sermon ever preached, the greatest preacher who ever lived, pleaded: "Enter in by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and many go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it." (Sermon on the Mount; preached by Jesus. Matthew 7:13-14)

Jesus preached that the gate opening to destruction is *wide* and the way leading to eternal damnation is *broad*. He warned and still warns, "*Do not enter?*"
