"You'll Never Graduate"



Posted on May 16, 2007 by Adam Faughn [NOTE: On Sunday, May 20, as so many other congregations do, the 9th Avenue church of Christ will be honoring our young people graduating from high school. This article was written with that in mind. It is a brief outline of one of the first sermons I ever preached in Somerville, *Tennessee, when I served as the youth minister there.*]

Nearly every TV show has had a character who heard the words that every high school student is afraid of: "You'll never graduate."

Graduation is simply a movement from one phase to another. It is as much a beginning as an ending. We all graduate many times in life. We graduate from childhood to adulthood; from single to married; from having children to the "empty nest."

There are, however, some things from which we never graduate. What are they? Here are just a few: Responsibility. Even as children, we have responsibilities around the house, whether it's cleaning our room or taking out the trash. As young people we have school responsibilities. As adults, we are responsible for so much (our work, our family's safety, the mortgage payments, etc.). Some people don't want any responsibilities, but they assume a responsibility by doing that! We must be responsible people.

• The need to pray. Little children are (hopefully) taught to pray by their parents. As adults, we like to think we have it all under control, but we really don't. We, very often, need to turn things over to God. We need to praise Him in prayer, and we need to let the worries of our life go up to Him. The more responsibility we assume, the more we need to pray.
