# January 6, 2019 Seridian Messenger Welcome Visitors! Making Your Reservations in Heaven

We all are familiar with songs about Heaven. Jesus made a promise a long time ago, not just to the apostles, but to all who would be Christians (Read John 14:1-7). Jesus knows He is going to leave the Apostles, but He will return. They are about to see Him, mocked, beaten, and killed before He could do greater things. He gives this message during the Last Supper. In John 14–16 are Jesus' words of comfort for His apostles to help them prepare for the disappointment ahead. They needed to make reservations in Heaven. ### 1) NEED A RESERVATION? SEEK THE RIGHT PURPOSE

- The right purpose is being righteous (Genesis 15:6) and working (Deuteronomy 27:10).
- •The right purpose is seeking the kingdom of God first (Matthew 6:33).
- •The right purpose is seeking salvation (Romans 10:9-10) and living right (Mark 1:15).
- •The right purpose comes from reading and accepting God's word (Romans 10:17).
- •The right purpose is acknowledging that faith must be accompanied by works (James 2:21).

# 2) NEED A RESERVATION? FIND THE RIGHT PLACE

- •The right place is the Father's house (Psalm 53:2, Matthew 5:34).
- •The right place is one of eternal fellowship with God (Matthew 25:31-46).
- •The right place is not made with hands (II Corinthians 5:1, I Corinthians 15:47).
- •The right place is only seen through the eyes of faith (II Corinthians 4:16-18).
- •The right place is a real city with real buildings and landscapes (Hebrews 11:13-16).
