The Holy Spirit in Paul's Letters ~ Part 2 of 2

Since the first of year we have been studying about the Holy Spirit. This is an exciting, but often misunderstood subject. We have considered the work of the Holy Spirit through the Gospels, Acts, Romans, and a few other letters of Paul. If you have your Bible handy you need to open to the book of Ephesians. It is a great place to learn about God's nature.

In the book of Ephesians Paul says that the Holy Spirit seals us unto the day of redemption (Ephesians 1:13, 4:30). This is consistent with things we have already learned from the book of acts, the book of Romans and other passages. For those who claim that they "do not" have the Holy Spirit of God are actually claiming not to have been saved (Acts 2:38-39, Romans 8, Titus 3:5).

In the book of Romans we learn something else that Paul illustrates in this letter, that is the Holy Spirit gives us access to God the Father (**Ephesians 2:18**). He, in fact, aids us in our prayers. The Holy Spirit also makes us God's habitation (**Ephesians 2:22**), as we are part of His temple (**I Corinthians 3:16-17**). Paul also reveals that the Holy Spirit reveals the mystery of God to us (**Ephesians 3:5**), He strengthens our spirits (**Ephesians 3:16**), and fills us (**Ephesians 5:18**, **Acts 2:4**, **4:8**, **31**, **9:17**).

The Holy Spirit brings unity and oneness to the body (**Ephesians 4:3, 2:14-18, 4:1-5:33**). As Paul finishes His letter He reveals that the Holy Spirit plays the same role as the Father and the Son (which we have already debunked tri-theism in a previous article). The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit are all One God! The Spirit plays the same role in the church that He does in the Godhead. When the Holy Spirit is operating in a group of people, He unites them in love. Therefore, evidence of the Holy Spirit working in a group is love and unity. The supernatural gifts, signs and wonders were seasonal and can be counterfeited, but now He resides in the life of every Christian believer bearing natural fruit (**Galatians 5:22-23**).

Paul's other letters teach us that the Holy Spirit supplies us with Christ (**Philippians 1:19**), He gives us joy (**I Thessalonians 1:6**), He sanctifies us (**II Thessalonians 2:13, Romans 5:16**), and He washes and renews us (**Titus 3:5**). I wish we had the time to look at every single verse that emphasized the Holy Spirit, but the bulletin just isn't that large! However, we will continue our series next week and consider additional teachings from Peter and John. Have a great week!
