The natural gifts of the Holy Spirit include teaching (**Romans 12:7, Ephesians 4:11**), leading a ministry (**Romans 12:7**), administration (**Romans 12:8, Hebrews 13:7**), evangelism (**Ephesians 4:11, II Timothy 4:5**), shepherding the flock (**Ephesians 4:11, I Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9**), exhorting/encouraging (**Romans 12:8**), liberal giving (**Romans 12:8**), showing mercy (**Romans 12:8**), assisting/helping those in need (**Romans 12:8**), strong faith (**Romans 12:3-6**). The time for the apostles and prophets would also fade away with the supernatural gifts, miracles, healings, and tongue speaking. This is why we see a slow progression of leadership from the Twelve to elderships that were appointed in each city, deacons that were appointed to serve the flock, and evangelists that preached in that community. I realize that this is a very "meaty" subject, but one that must not be neglected. I strongly encourage you to keeping your faith through Bible study. Take your Bible (and possibly a concordance) and go through all the passages that talk about the Holy Spirit and His work. It will be a fruitful study!
