John spoke to the church in his first epistle and stated "you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things" (I John 2:20). 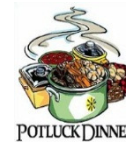
What, then, is the verse in the center of the Bible? Psalms 118:8
