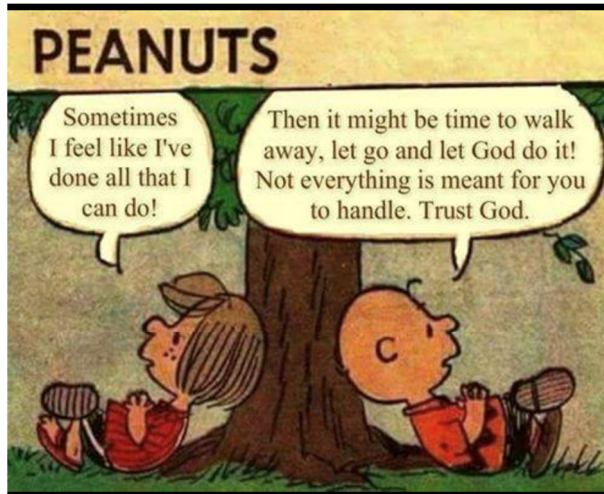
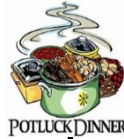

Following the Lord was part of Solomon's conclusion in **Ecclesiastes 12:12-13**, "Now, everything has been heard, so I give my final advice: Honor God and obey his commands, because this is all people must do.
