The Living Church

In Sunday's call to worship, Lucas read a quote which served as a reminder that even though being together in a traditional way is impossible, Christ's church is very much alive. Because of the circumstances, it is a tough time to be a follower of Jesus. In fact, I don't know about you, but I have a renewed understanding in why God purposed the church to be a community of believers. I am so thankful that we truly are part of a living church, and I want to share two things that are always true because Christ's church is alive.

A living church means an ever-present mission field. It may seem that the mission field is all but dried up right now, but nothing could be farther from the truth!
