

# GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP SERVICES

- Mitigate (lessen) exposure by implementing social distancing guidelines – stay at least 6 feet from people in your building, do not hug or shake hands.
- Encourage members of your church to stay home if they are symptomatic, have fever, or have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive.
- Consider strongly encouraging the use of face coverings (covering nose and mouth) by all persons in the house of worship. Consider having supply of face coverings available at entrances to offer to individuals if requested.
- Communion cups with bread will be placed in communion cup holders on the back of each pew in front of you.
- No collection plate will be passed. Please leave contribution in basket on table at back of auditorium.
- Restrooms: In order to keep restrooms sanitized, please spray toilet/urinals/sinks when finished. A can of disinfectant is on the back of each toilet, urinal, as well as on each countertop.
- Do not enter fellowship hall.

# GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP SERVICES

## AMENITIES

- If you can answer “YES” to any of the following questions, please do not enter building:
  - Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19 in the past 14 days?
  - Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat?
  - Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?
  - Have you had new loss of taste or smell?
  - Have you had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?
- Hand sanitizer is available at various stations inside the building: foyer (guestbook area; table at street-side doors) as well as restrooms.
- Face masks are to be worn, covering mouth and nose at all times. We have a few masks if you need one.
- Access only to foyer, restrooms, and auditorium. Please DO NOT ENTER the fellowship hall area, nor kitchen area.
- Once service is concluded, leave the building immediately. Instructions will be given on exiting the building to avoid close contact with others.
