There are many factors that play into being a successful athlete. Many of those things can and should be perfected through practicing. For a basketball player, they only way for him to increase his free-throw percentage is to spend time practicing it. For a quarterback to increase his completion percentage, he has to work on his accuracy in practice. Working on these skills are extremely important for athletes, but there is one thing many athletes will tell you is key to success, just as much as those important skills. The key is confidence. A player could hit every free-throw in practice, but if he lacks confidence, when he steps up to the free-throw line with the game hanging in the balance, chances are, he is going to miss his shot. Just as confidence is important in an athlete's game, it carries a great amount of importance in the lives of Christians.

As a Christian, washed in the blood of Jesus, I am made righteous in the eyes of God.
