Introduction: If we want to continue being 'partakers of the divine nature", we must add to our perseverance godliness. The word for "godliness" signifies "that piety, which, characterized by a Godward attitude, does that which is well-pleasing to Him" (Vine's, p. 502). Godliness may be possessed by the unsaved, as well as the saved, for it is the adjective form of this work that Luke uses to describe the unsaved Cornelius as "a devout man" (Acts 10:1,2). Thus, godliness alone will not get one into heaven, though one cannot get into heaven without it.

NOT MERELY GOOD CONDUCT

- A. One's motive for his conduct may be improper (1 Timothy 6:3-5).
- B. A mere "form of godliness" is insufficient (2 Timothy 3:5; Matthew 23:14,27,28).

AN ATTITUDE TOWARD GOD

- A. A constant sense of being "before God" (Acts 10:33; 23:1).
- B. A constant sense of being "with God" (Genesis 5:24; 6:9; Micah 6:8).
- C. That attitude which prays, "Be with me, Lord! No other gift or blessing Thou couldst bestow could with this one compare—A constant sense of Thy abiding presence. Where'er I am, to feel that Thou are near."

WILL PRODUCE GOOD CONDUCT

- A. Conduct, which necessarily glorifies God (1 Corinthians 10:31)
- B. Godliness will be manifested in our:
 - 1. Eating (1 Corinthians 6:12,13)
 - 2. Dress (1 Timothy 2:9; 1 Peter 3:3,4)
 - Service to both God and man (Colossians 3:22-24)
 - Dealings with the lost (1 Peter 2:12)
 - Relation to civil government (Romans 13:1; Titus 3:1)
 - Recreation (1 Timothy 4:7,8; 1 John 2:15-17)
 - 7. Thoughts (Philippians 4:8)

WILL PRODUCE GOOD CONDUCT

- A. Persecution (2 Timothy 3:12; Matthew 5:11,12)
- Deliverance from temptation (2 Peter 2:9; 1 Corinthians 10:13)
- When coupled with contentment, "great gain" (1 Timothy 6:6-8)
- D. Life that now is, and that which is to come (1 Timothy 4:7,8; Mark 10:28-30)

Conclusion: Do you possess that attitude of nearness to God, which displays itself in proper conduct in every aspect of your life? Without such, you cannot continue to be a partaker of the divine nature! Ω
