It is possible that at some point in your life you have read or heard Mark 16:15-16, read and thought to yourself, how is that possible? You want me to go into all the world? Do you know how big that is, God? "Yes, I know I created it, and I want you to start with your circle and change your world." Young people, we must see the need to change this world; to bring the people of this world back to God.

The Pew Forum on Religion & Public Life survey suggested that most American religious believers, including most Christians, say eternal life is not exclusively for those who accept Christ as their savior.

Of the 65% of people who held this open view of Heaven's gates, 80% named at least one non-Christian group — Jews, Muslims, Hindus, atheists, or people with no religion at all — who may also be saved.

The survey confirms what we've known for a long time: American churchgoers are friendly people who aren't into the details of theology, especially the part about who goes to Heaven and who goes to Hell. We are suffering from this pick-and-choose what doctrines want to believe mentality. We say things like, "I'll take the love of God, but I'm going to skip that stuff about Judgment and Hell." We want no part of loving difficult people or taking up our cross. That's too hard for us.

When we follow Christ, we don't live as the world lives. We don't give as the world gives. We are different, set apart. Young people, you and I together can make a difference in our own world, one person at a time. How do we do it? How do we change the thoughts of man? How do we show the world, Jesus? It starts with our example. The things we say and the things we do are seen everywhere we go. The minute we forget this and let our guard down will be when we teach the wrong lesson. Listen to what Jesus taught his disciples on the mountain in Matthew 5: 14-16. ~continued inside~
