## **QUESTION:** What is your favorite verse of Scripture? (D.D.)

**Response:** A difficult question to answer, because there are so many favorites, but here is one I have been meditating on lately:

"We love because He first loved us" (1 John 4:19). The King James Version of the Bible, what Hugo McCord called "My mother's Bible," has, "We love Him because He first loved us." The context shows "Him" would refer to God, and the fact that it is in italics indicates it was not in the original Greek text but was supplied by the translators. So, the KJV translators took a general statement, "We love because He first loved us," and made it more specific, "We love Him (God) because He first loved us."

The more specific statement is true, of course. Our love for God, both Father and Son, is motivated and inspired by Their love for us, in the Father's sacrifice of His Son on the cross. Jesus says, "And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself" (John 12:32). The next verse (12:33) explains, "He said this to show by what kind of death He was to die." To paraphrase, Jesus is saying, "If I die on the cross, that sacrifice, that evidence of my and the Father's love, will cause many to believe in and love me." Also, Paul says, "The love of Christ controls us" (1 Corinthians 5:1-4).

However, the more general statement, without the "Him" is also true. "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us" (Romans 5:5). The Holy Spirit-inspired gospel of the love and grace of God has been proclaimed to us and we have received and believed it. Thereby, we have learned of a new kind of love, biblical agape' love, love "as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her" (Ephesians 5:25). That is a self-sacrificial love, a love that is a matter of will rather than of feeling. Remember, "Christ died for the ungodly" (Romans 5:6), and "God shows His love for us in that, while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). So, Jesus commands us, "Love your enemies" (Matthew 5:44). "Love" in all those passages is agape', the love with which...~continued inside~
